GCI has completed the installation of the Southeast Alaskan fiber optic communications cable system this summer and it is currently in operation.


As previously described this cable system links and provides vital high speed internet and communication services to the communities of Southeast Alaska. Please find enclosed the as-built position lists for this cable system. Also provided are pictorial charts as an easy reference for the locations in South East Alaska the cable passes through.

Please pass these along throughout the fishing community, such that fisherman can use them to update their charts and electronic navigation. Notice has been provided to NOAA, and a Notice to Mariners as well as updated charts should be provided in the next release. Be reminded that if fishing gear is believed to be snagged on the cable, GCI should be called immediately at 1-888-442-8662 or 907-868-5555 for instruction. This number is manned 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
